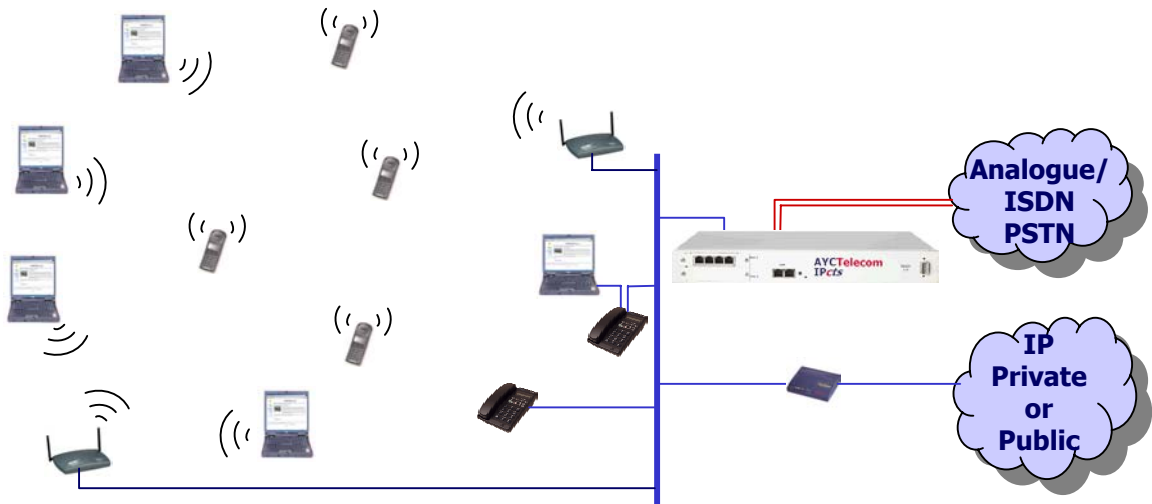


IP*cts* Wireless Application



As the IPcTs is an IP Telephony system it is possible to use Wireless IP handsets with it. Standard wireless LAN Access Point equipment is used as the mechanism to connect a call from a wireless handset to the IPcTs system. An environment could partially or completely wireless allowing wireless PC's and wireless handsets to use the same wireless LAN infrastructure.

A user could have a desktop telephone and a wireless handset and then set up diverts between the two devices using the CTI application thus enabling a user to be contactable when away from their desk.

Being able to fulfil a wireless application has significant benefits in some scenarios where running cables to a desk difficult or near impossible or maybe even prohibited in the case of some listed buildings. Applications such as Car Showrooms, Warehouses, Schools and other 'open' environments.
